ACTION REQUESTED:

Move to approve the Chair's cosignature with the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court to the Interlocal Agreement and full BOCC sign the accompanying Kittitas County Resolution which empowers the relationship.

BACKGROUND:

The Administrative Office of the Courts administers funds provided by the Washington State Legislature for the provision of BECCA Bill services (At Risky Youth, Children in Need of Services and truancy.) A funded amount is allotted to each County's Juvenile Court to reimburse the statutorily required Court (and some support) services. This agreement provides the details for reimbursement when those services are applied.

INTERACTION:

The Juvenile Court Administrator (JCA), who is the statutorily identified agent to locally administer BECCA programs, received a proposed agreement from the Office of the Administrator of the Courts (AOC) for State Fiscal Year 2013 and provided same to the assigned County legal advisor and Auditor's Office. AOC subsequently withdrew the proffered agreement and replaced it with a "version 2." That agreement was reviewed and approved as to form by the designated County legal advisor. A County Resolution format was also provided to ensure compliance with County process. The document was initially provided for review by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court as the administrative authority of the court by Court Rule and will be presented for his signature prior to the original documents being presented for signature.

RECOMMENDATION:

Respectfully request signatures on originals of the Interlocal Agreement and accompanying Resolution.

HANDLING:

Request return to JCA to obtain AOC authorized signature for final original document to be processed then filed at the Commissioners' office.
