ACTION REQUESTED:

Request Board of County commissioners signatures on the Agreement with King County.

BACKGROUND:

This agreement previously went in front of the Board in 2011 and forwarded to King County. King County was delayed in taking action and have asked Kittitas County to resign the agreement so they can start the process over.

This agreement will allow Waste Management to pick up garbage in the Snoqualmie Pass area of King County and dispose of it at the Cle Elum Transfer station. This agreement it to acknowledge a practice that has been going on since 1986. King County has been tightening up it boarders in order to limit the amount of garbage being diverted out of there system.
