ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve PSE Claim for Damages

BACKGROUND:

On May 1, 2012 near Godawa and Lower Peoh Point road, a County roller damaged some equipment belonging to Puget Sound Energy valued at \$16,804.21. The claim was brought before the BOCC on October 16, 2012 and concern was expressed that the County was being double billed. Public Works has looked at that again and are satisfied that the County is not being double billed and that the amount of \$16,804.21 is an accurate reflection of the damage caused.

INTERACTION:

PSE filed a claim against the County and the Prosecutor's Office requested input from Public Works who advised approving the claim.

RECOMMENDATION:

It appears that the County vehicle is responsible for the damage to PSE's equipment and so should reimburse them for the damage we caused. Approve payment in the amount of \$16,804.21 after receipt of an executed release of claim form.
