

the City of Ellensburg's property tax levy ordinance for 2013; and


WHEREAS, RCW 84.52.020 requires that the City Council file the City's levy

November; and


WHEREAS, purpose of the levy certification is to certify the total amount to be

ORDINANCE NO. 4621

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON, LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2013, ON ALL PROPERTY IN SAID CITY WHICH IS SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING SUFFICIENT REVENUE TO CARRY ON GENERAL OPERATIONS, RECOGNIZE VOTER APPROVED LEVIES AND PAY DEBT SERVICE OBLIGATIONS OF SAID CITY AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ellensburg has met and considered its budget for 2013-2014 biennial budget pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

WHEREAS, the City's actual levy amount from previous year was \$2,544,889.93; and

WHEREAS, the population of the city is more than 10,000, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELLENSBURG, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. General Tax Levy for 2013. An increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2013 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from previous year shall be \$25,448.90 which is a percentage increase of 1% from previous year.

This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of the state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

Section 2. Excess Tax Levy for 2013. In addition to the above levies for the ensuing fiscal year of 2013, there shall be and are hereby levied current taxes of \$153,103.00, the purpose of which is to retire the outstanding obligation incurred by the City for general obligation bonds that have been issued after an affirmative vote of the citizens in favor thereof.

Section 3. Majority Approval. This ordinance was passed by a majority of the entire Council.


Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.




