A Resolution Authorizing Execution of a Shoreline Management Act Grant Agreement between the Department of Ecology and Kittitas County

- WHEREAS, the Washington State Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58) and its associated rules (WAC 173-26) require local governments to develop and administer shoreline master programs that include policies and regulations that govern designated shorelines within their respective jurisdictions; and
- WHEREAS, Kittitas County and Cities/Town are required to update their shoreline master programs by December 1, 2013 [RCW 90.58 (2)(a)(v)]; and
- WHEREAS, on October 12, 2011 Kittitas County received a grant funding commitment of \$690,000.00 from Ecology for the update process; and
- WHEREAS, Kittitas County and the Cities/Town have entered into an Interlocal Agreement pursuant to Chapter 39.34 RCW and have agreed to coordinate updates to their shoreline master programs using grant funding from Ecology; and
- WHEREAS, Kittitas County has agreed to manage and administer the grant as shown on the SMA Grant Agreement No. G1200054 attached hereto as "Exhibit A"; and
- WHEREAS, The effective date of the grant agreement is from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2014, unless terminated sooner as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the attached SMA Grant Agreement No. G1200054 between the State of Washington Department of Ecology and Kittitas County be executed for the Regional Comprehensive Shoreline Master Program Update Project in the form of Exhibit A attached hereto.
