ACTION REQUESTED:

Chair sign document. Full Board approve signature.

BACKGROUND:

SSODA (Special Sex Offender Disposition Alternative) is a statutory Disposition (sentencing) option for qualifying juvenile offenders. WA. ST. DSHS/JRA provides funding through contract with the Juvenile Court to provide the option as described in statute. Crest Counseling is a qualified provider and has served the Juvenile Court for decades. This is a renewal of that relationship for the current biennium with current Kittitas County language. Two JRA documents are also included which are required for subcontractors to sign which have been signed.

INTERACTION:

The Juvenile Court Services Department assigned legal advisor reviewed the document, offered verbiage updates and has approved as to form. The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court has signed the document.

RECOMMENDATION:

Sign the document to continue the ability for SSODA through a qualified provider.
