2021 BUDGET

AUDITOR

JUDY PLESS, BUDGET & FINANCE MANAGER reviewed the proposed 2021 annual budget and draft Resolutions. The General Fund for municipal purposes for the year 2021 according to the assessed valuation as determined in the year 2020 includes the General Fund (Current Expense) \$8,931,726.00; Community Services \$223,274.00; and Veterans Assistance \$45,000.00 for a total of \$9,200,000.00.

THOSE PRESENT & TESTIFYING: VAL BARSCHAW, CLERK explained how she is dissatisfied with the IT Department not being able to provide her accurate budget numbers for the 5th year in a row and urged the Board to take corrective action. THERE BEING NO OTHERS REQUESTING TO TESTIFY, THE PUBLIC PORTION OF THE HEARING WAS CLOSED.
