#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM.

### DISCUSSION – CONSIDER AMENDMENT TO COUNTY CODE – INDEMNIFICATION OF COUNTY OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AND VOLUNTEERS

Deputy Prosecutor Horner summarized that the Prosecutor's Office would like to start a discussion to adopt an indemnification policy. He explained that the current statute is vague and allows for Counties to create their own detailed and favorably worded policy. Commissioner Wright asked how the proposed process would be initiated, and what would happen if there was a disagreement between the Board and the Prosecutor's Office. DPA Horner answered that the process would begin when an employee is sued and requests legal assistance from the County. The Board would then decide to approve or deny the request. If a disagreement arose in the decision-making process, the Board would typically have final authority. Commissioner Wright commented that the term "volunteer" in the draft policy is very broad and asked if that was the intent of the policy. DPA Horner responded that the term "volunteer" is included in the statute and therefore included in the proposed policy. He stated that the County is responsible for anyone who does any work for the County. The Board approved moving forward was the indemnification policy. DPA Horner will work with BOCC and Prosecutor staff to schedule a public hearing.
