FEBRUARY BUILDING PERMIT ACTIVITY

CDS Director Dan Carlson presented PowerPoint with the residential building permit applications and issued permits activity for January and February of 2018-2021. Commissioner Osiadacz asked if there was a projection if this increase would continue throughout the year or if it was due to the code change. Director Carlson stated he believes the increase in permits will increase.

FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION VIDEO

CDS Director Dan Carlson presented Fire and Life Safety Inspection video. Due to audio issues the link to the video will be forwarded to the Commissioners after the meeting. Through the SmartGov system, the Fire Marshal has been able to track what the most common violations are. In January 2020 CDS entered into a contract with Central Washington University video production program to create a video of common violations and ways to correct these violations. This video will be shared with our businesses and posted on our website. The plan is to create more videos on topics that would be a helpful tool for people. Commissioner Osiadacz asked that when the videos get uploaded
