Pat Deneen stated that if the Board would pursue an Emergency Declaration from the President it would be helpful to all those trying to rebuild after the snowfall.

BOARD DISCUSSION/DECISION ITEMS

APPOINTMENT JAMES DONALDSON/BOARD OF HEALTH COMMISSIONERS

Tristen Lamb, Public Health Director presented the Board with a request to appoint James Donaldson to the County Board of Health. She stated that last sessions Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 1152 requires that local Board of Health be comprised of equal parts community representatives and elected officials. She stated that the current composition of the Board of Health does not satisfy the requirements of E2SHB 1152. She stated that a Public Notice was done to recruit members and a Special Purpose Committee (SPC) was formed to interview and make a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioner's. She stated that one of the members of the Special Purpose Committee was here to answer questions if the Board had any. Andrew Lyons, Special Purpose Committee Member explained the process the SPC went through and expressed full

support of the Board appointing Mr. Donaldson.

Vice-Chairman Wright moved to appoint James Donaldson to the Kittitas County Board of Health for a 3-year term effective immediately and ending on 2/1/2025. Commissioner Wachsmith seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

CLOSED RECORD MEETING

RONALD PUD (RZ-07-000017)

CDS

Jeremiah Cromie, Staff Planner, reviewed a Staff Report for the approval of the Ronald PUD Final Development Plan (RZ-07-000017). He stated this was for a phased development of up to 438 residential units and a possible hotel on 21.13 acres through Ordinance 2011-009. He stated that the Ronald PUD included a Rezone and Short Plat applications (RZ-07-000017 and SP-07-00168) processed and approved concurrently. He stated the short plat has since expired and the final development plan consists of up to 438 units on 102 lots located west of Ronald at milepost 8 on SR 903. He stated that the property is located in Section 12, T20N, R14E, WM in Kittitas County. Map Numbers 20-14-12070-00012 and 20-14-12041-0001 are to be used for roads and stormwater improvements for the planned unit development.

Vice-Chairman Wright moved to conduct a Closed Record Hearing and to consider approval for the Ronald PUD Final Development Plan. Commissioner Wachsmith seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
