

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF LAND SURVEYED
 THE SOUTH HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER, AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER, OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 16 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO POST THE WEST LINE OF THE ABOVE DESCRIBED LANDS AND TO MAP FOUND OR RECOVERED MONUMENTS OWNED LANDS TO THE WEST OF AND ADJUTING SAID LINE.

NARRATIVE

* A DISCREPANCY WAS DISCOVERED IN REGARD TO THE TRUE POSITION OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26. ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE FOR SAID 1/4 CORNER WAS NEVER RECOVERED.

* IN 1878, LOREN F. JAY, P.L.S. #1967, SET SAID 1/4 CORNER BY SINGLE PROPORTION HOLDING THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26 AS AN ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE AND FROM WHAT HE FELT TO BE ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 26 TO THE WEST BEING A CORNER THAT HE ALSO SET FROM WHAT HE FELT TO BE ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE. (REFER TO RECORD OF SURVEY FILED IN BOOK 6 OF SURVEYS AT PAGE 894598. SURVEYED SAID SECTION 26 FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF GAME, AS PER AN UNRECORDED SURVEY ON FILE AT THE PUBLIC LAND SURVEY OFFICE IN OLYMPIA, MR. PITZLER ACCEPTED THE SECTION CORNER POSITION MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY TO THE WEST BUT DID NOT SET THE SECTION CORNER POSITION TO THE EAST. MR. PITZLER SET AN ADDITIONAL MONUMENT FOR THE POSITION OF SAID SECTION CORNER TO THE EAST FROM WHAT HE FELT TO BE ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE, WHICH HE NOTED TO BEAR S30°43'55"W FOR A DISTANCE OF 172.84 FEET FROM THE POSITION MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY. MR. PITZLER DID NOT SET THE SECTION CORNER POSITION TO THE WEST AS MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY, AND SET A NEW MONUMENT BY SINGLE PROPORTION HOLDING HIS MONUMENTED POSITION OF SAID SECTION CORNER TO THE EAST AND SAID SECTION CORNER TO THE WEST THAT WAS MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY. 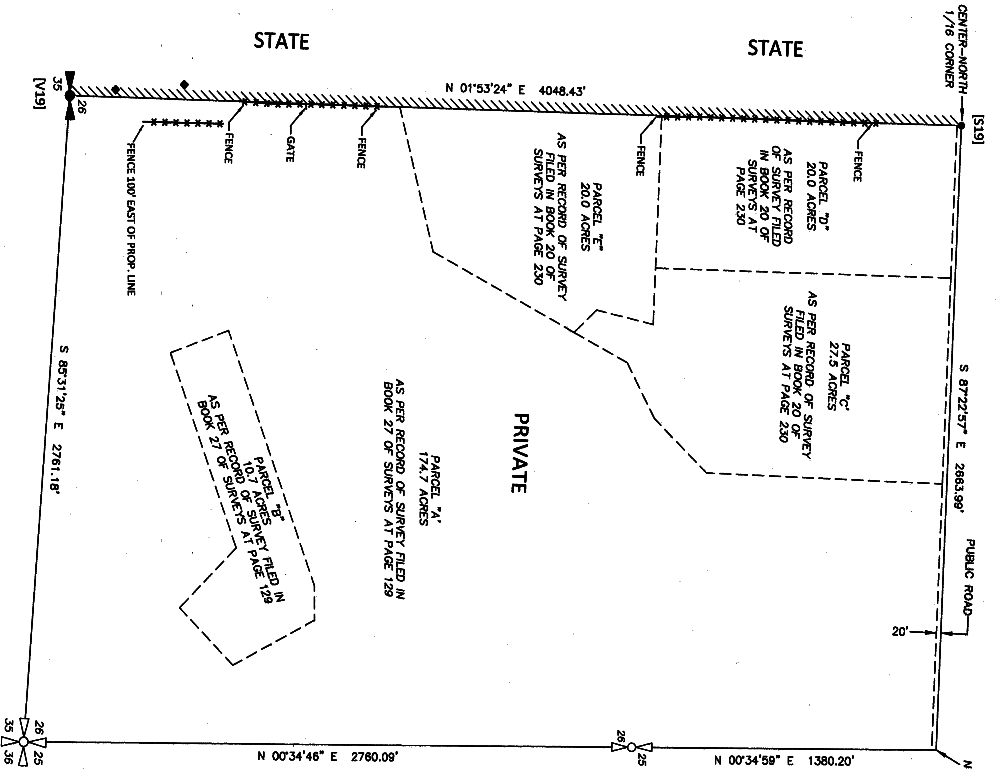

 CORNER TIES, SETS AND GROUND TRAVERSEES WERE PERFORMED WITH A TOPCON GP-7500 DIGITAL TOTAL STATION. TIES TO REFERENCES WERE MADE WITH A HAND COMPASS AND STEEL TAPE. LINEAR AND ANGULAR CLOSURES EXCEEDED THOSE SHOWN IN WAC 352-150-0980 FOR LANDLIFT AND TRANSVERS.

SURVEYOR'S NOTES:

* THERE ARE TWO MONUMENTS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26. ONE SET BY LOREN F. JAY IN 1879 FROM AN ORIGINAL BT AND ONE SET BY DONALD W. PITZLER (LAND SURVEYOR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME) IN 1980 PURPORTEDLY FROM AN ORIGINAL BT. IN 1997, JAMES S. ENGBELHARD (SOUTHEAST REGION LAND SURVEYOR FOR THE DNR) FOUND AN ADDITIONAL ORIGINAL BT DIMENSIONED AS A CORNER TO THE WEST AS MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY. THIS DIMENSION AFFECTS THE SINGLE PROPORTIONED POSITION OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE CALCULATED POSITION OF THE CENTER-NORTH 1/16 CORNER IN SECTION 26. HOWEVER, BECAUSE THE STATE ACQUIRED THE PROPERTY IN 1980 AND THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME (AS PER AN UNRECORDED SURVEY ON FILE AT THE PUBLIC LAND SURVEY OFFICE IN OLYMPIA, MR. PITZLER SET AN ADDITIONAL MONUMENT FOR THE POSITION OF SAID SECTION CORNER TO THE EAST FROM WHAT HE FELT TO BE ORIGINAL G.L.O. EVIDENCE, WHICH HE NOTED TO BEAR S30°43'55"W FOR A DISTANCE OF 172.84 FEET FROM THE POSITION MONUMENTED BY MR. JAY. MR. 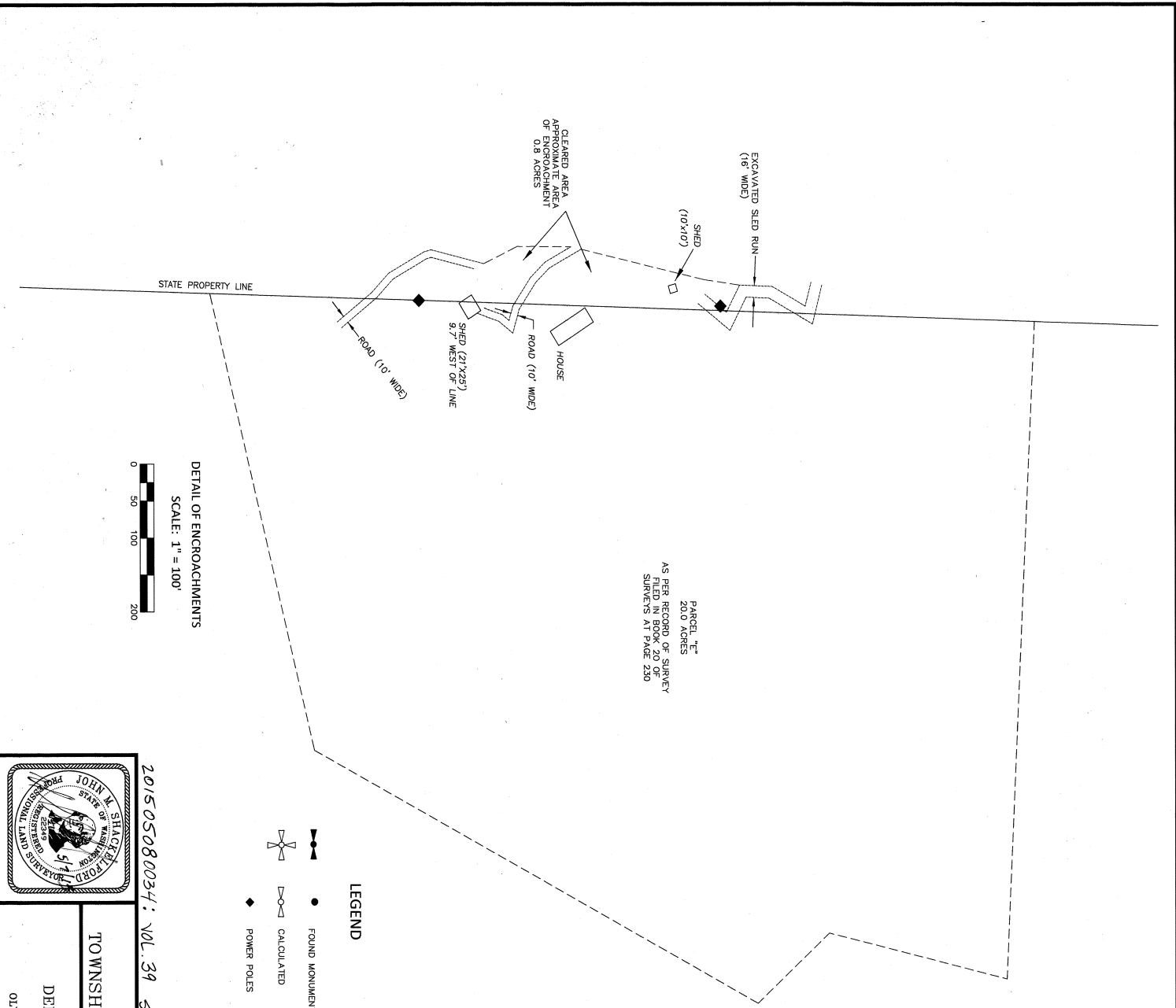
