County Survey review of Niles Boundary Line Adjustment BL-16-00015

Required Changes:

- 1. The legend referencing found monuments should include the cap details (LS#12491) or if no cap, it should be noted.
- 2. Replace "10' Irrig. Ease" with "Ex. 10' Irrig. Ease (AFN:408865)" or similar.
- 3. Label the distance of fence encroachment on Alford Rd R/W, it appears to be about 7-8 feet.
- 4. Label Wilson Creek Rd and Alford Rd with the name, width, ownership and surfacing material of the roadway (EX. 60' County R/W Paved)
- 5. Include the distance ties to the NE and W section corners

Suggested Changes (not required)

- 1. Land Corner Records should be created/referenced, OR reference ties to Section corners shown on the face of the Plat (RCW:58.09.060). This is going to start being enforced Jan 1, 2017.
- Lot Closure reports submitted with application. This is going to start being enforced Jan. 1, 2017.
