The Public Works Department has reviewed the Request for Boundary Line Adjustment Application. In order to ensure that it meets current Kittitas County Road Standards, the applicant needs to provide the following prior to final approval:

- 1. A revised legal description that describes the final configuration of the subject property shall be required.
- 2. A survey map for review. Any comments regarding survey will be reserved for final.
- 3. Show access easements on the face of the BLA.

The applicant needs to be aware of the following:

- a. An approved access permit shall be required from the Kittitas County Department of Public Works prior to creating any new driveway access or changing an existing access.
- b. Maintenance of driveway approaches shall be the responsibility of the owner whose property they serve. The County will not maintain accesses.
- c. Any further subdivision or lots to be served by proposed access may result in further access requirements. See Kittitas County Road Standards.
- d. The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) transmission easement burdens each lot in the application. Access must not be blocked to any transmission facilities. Any activity that is to occur within the right-of-way needs to be permitted by BPA.
- e. Evidence of existing access and/or evidence of access to be created should be confirmed prior to sale of property.
- f. Access is not guaranteed to any existing or created parcel on this application.

In addition to the above-mentioned conditions, all applicable Kittitas County Road Standards apply to this proposal. Please let me know if you have any questions or need further information.

## Mitigation/Metering:

No mitigation requirements for boundary line adjustments. For future domestic, commercial or industrial development- new uses of groundwater will be required to obtain water mitigation and install a water meter per Kittitas County Code 13.35.027 and 13.40.030.
