Dear Kelly,

I believe you are looking at the wrong map. Jeremy (I think that's the planner's name) rejected the initial survey on the grounds that the smaller property didn't match the original acreage, so Gray's Surveying in Yakima redid the map. Now the two parcels are 14.6+ and 23.8+; the initial problem arose when Gray's survey did not match the deed descriptions. My place (parcel 696333) originally on the deed said 14.7 acres, and the contiguous property that I bought in about 1994 was 24.5 acres (parcel 287934). However, their survey showed that some property had been subtracted from my place; he said it was land taken by the road right of way, or the curvature that wasn't calculated correctly. The other property had 23.86, not 24.5 like it says on the deed. The irony here is that these discrepancies are either caused by the state or an inaccurate survey way back when.

If Jeremy can't produce the other map I can bring it in.
