The Public Works Department has reviewed the Request for Boundary Line Adjustment Application.

The applicant needs to be aware of the following:

- 1.) An approved access permit shall be required from the Kittitas County Department of Public Works prior to creating any new driveway access or altering an existing access.
- 2.) Maintenance of driveway approaches shall be the responsibility of the owner whose property they serve. The County will not maintain accesses.
- 3.) Any further subdivision or lots to be served by proposed access may result in further access requirements. See Kittitas County Road Standards.
- 4.) Driveway on parcel 29B comes close to new proposed boundary line of parcel 29A. Applicant should be aware that no driveway or road shall be constructed within five feet of the side yard boundary, unless the driveway or road is part of an easement shared with the neighboring property owner (KCC 12.05.080).
- 5.) In addition to the above-mentioned conditions, all applicable Kittitas County Road Standards apply to this proposal. Access is not guaranteed to any existing or created parcel on this application.
- 6.) As the application does not contain a survey map, comments are reserved until final.
