The mitigation condition states:

VII. HISTORIC AND CULTURAL PRESERVATION

1. The project shall be constructed and operated pursuant to the August 2009 Cultural Resources Report, referenced in the expanded SEPA Checklist.

The report recommendation (and now a mitigation requirement) is to conduct limited shovel areas likely contain cultural materials as show in Figure 5-1. This shovel testing is required prior to any construction/installation. The applicant also recently inquired about doing some limited geotechnical testing on the site. We advised the applicant that the shovel testing needed to be completed prior to any land disturbance related to geotechnical testing. I believe they plan to do the work soon. Would you like the applicant's representative contact info or like us to advise you of the timing for the work to coordinate

being on-site with them? I know their contact (Nichole Seidell) has been trading vms and emails with Kris from the Yakama Nation.

For your use, I have also attached the SEPA staff report that outline others requirements under existing laws and codes (see page 34 and 35).
