The Department of Public Works has reviewed the permit for the WDFW Hwy 10 Boat Ramp Conditional Use Permit and has the following comments:

- A. Transportation Concurrency: After consultation with the Washington State Department of Transportation, a Determination of Concurrency Finding has been issued for this project under number TC-15-00001. No mitigation is required of this project.
- B. Site Access: All requirements of WSDOT must be complied with.
- C. Floodplain Development Permit: A flood permit must be acquired prior to beginning any work within the 100-year floodplain according to the regulations in KCC 14.08.
- D. Grading Permit: A grading permit must be acquired prior to beginning any site work on the property according to the regulations within KCC 14.05.
