- June 10th and 11th on a master plan & development agreement that has been in process for the last three years. These technical working meetings will involve about a dozen participants in a final wrap up meeting that has taken years to get to this point. These meeting were scheduled weeks ago. But, had I known that the County knew as early as May 15<sup>th</sup> that it wanted to schedule a hearing for June 11<sup>th</sup>, and was so notified at that time, I would certainly could have sought a different date for the Redmond meetings, or sought a continuance here much earlier. However, my client, its consultants, and the City are all now locked into these two meeting days in Redmond and this cannot be changed at this point.
- 4. The importance of my participation in the Redmond meetings cannot be overstated. It is a two-block high-density urban mixed-use project in Redmond's Overlake Village that adjoins the Microsoft Campus with over 885 dwelling units, hotel/convention center, a medical office building, plus retail units. The final meetings establish the conditions of on-site and off-site mitigation, impact fee credits, affordable housing requirements, public benefits, final minimum and maximum densities, transportation improvements and latecomer's agreement provisions. This critical meeting tiers/triggers and sets later hearing dates for scheduling before the City's Design Review Board and the City Council later during the remainder of the summer. I cannot miss possibly attending these two all-day meetings that I will chair on behalf of the applicant, not to mention directing preparation and consultant presentations before and during these two meeting days.
