Dear Applicant,

Your application for a Conditional Use Permit (CU-18-00001) proposing to construct and operate a 230 kv transmission line from Pacific Power's Pomona Heights Substation located east of Selah, WA in Yakima County, to Bonneville Power Administration's Vantage Substation located east of the Wanapum Dam in Grant County has been determined complete as of August 13, 2018.

Continued processing of your application will include, but is not limited to, the following actions:

1. Posting of the property by the applicant is required along each street frontage. Due to the project size CDS will provide instructions on adequate posting. Signage may be obtained at the Community Development Services offices during regular business hours.
2. A Notice of Application will be published in the newspaper and sent to all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
3. Consideration of written comments from all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
4. Notification of a Public Hearing date.

You may pick up the "Land Use Action" sign at the CDS office during regular business hours to be posted on-site so it is visible to the traveling public and return the signed affidavit of posting to my attention. Applicants are encouraged to provide photos of site posting with the signed affidavit of posting. After this has been completed I will be able to issue the Notice of Application.
