Proposal: The project application proposes the use of the existing school building as well as the addition of a multipurpose building for the use by the co-op school. The facilities would be mainly used on Thursday afternoons during the spring and fall for homeschool co-op classes and the Multipurpose building would be used for occassional sports and events for the co-op school. The subject parcel is zoned Commercial Agriculture with a Commercial Agriculture land use designation. New Schools are allowed in this zone with a Conditional Use Permit.

A copy of the threshold determination may be obtained from the County once made.

Public Hearing: An open record hearing will be scheduled before the Kittitas County Hearing Examiner. A Public Hearing Notice will be issued establishing the date, time, and location of this hearing.
