Right of Way Deed Washington.

Know all men by these presents, that M. C. Ballard and Minnie P. Ballard his wife, of Kittitas County, State of Washington, Tex and in consideration of one dollar paid them in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby convey and warrant unto Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. of Washington, its successors and assigns, a strip of land, one hundred feet in width, extending over and across from the west side of the following described tract of land situated in the County of Kittitas, State of Washington, and described as follows, to wit: The southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section No. 20, in Township No. 19 N., of Range No. 27 E. W. M. Surveying a strip, belt or piece of land fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the Railway of said Company, so located and established over and across said land, on the southwest side of the Yakima River. And said grantees, for themselves and for their heirs, assigns and legal representatives, hereby release all damages and claims theye to, to all their other lands, by reason of or occasioned by the location, construction, maintenance and operation of a Railway over and upon the premises hereby surveyed. And said grantees, for themselves and for their heirs, assigns, or legal representatives, covenant and agree that said grants are upon no other consideration than that named herein, that neither said Railway Company nor its agents have made any agreement, written or conditions, verbal or written, for or relating to any crossing, easement, or other privilege, over, across or under said Railway, and that the right thereto shall be only that conferred by statute, or by an instrument in writing under the corporate seal of said Railway Company.

Garrison, his wife, of Kittitas County, State of Washington, for and in consideration of ten Dollars, to them in hand received, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby convey and transfer unto the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Company of Washington, its successors and assigns two strips of land, being parts and parcels of the following described tract of land situated in the County of Kittitas, State of Washington, and described as follows: to wit: The northwest quarter (N.W. 1/4) of section No. 25 in Township No. 19 North of Range No. 17 East, E. M. said strips being described as follows: 1. A strip of land fifty (50) feet in width lying on the westerly side of, contiguous and parallel to, the right of way strip heretofore conveyed by said Grantors to said Railway Company and extending in length from a point opposite station 2400 of the located line of railway of said Company southerly to a point opposite station 2405, a distance of 500 feet. 2.
