This Indenture, made this 3rd day of February, A. D. 1914 between M. C. Ballard of the County of Kittitas State of Washington party of the first part, and the Northern Pacific Railway Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Wisconsin, WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in performance of the agreement between Cascade Lumber Company, and the Northern Pacific Railway Company dated Nov. 24, 1913, the party of the first part has GRANTED, and by these presents does GRANT, to the said Railway Company, its suc-

cessors and assigns, the following described premises, situate in the County of Kittitas and State of Washington to-wit:

That certain tract or strip of land sixteen (16) feet in width, being eight (8) feet on each side of the center line of the certain spur track or siding which is now located or may be located and constructed across the premises of the party of the First Part, described as follows:

The southwest quarter of the northeast quarter (S W $\frac{1}{4}$ of N E $\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty (20), township nineteen (19) north of range seventeen (17) east of the Willamette Meridian.

For a more particular description, and as explanatory hereof, reference is made to the attached Plat, which is hereby made a part of this indenture.

To have and to hold said premises unto said Railway Company, its successors and assigns, according to the conditions in said agreement stated.

Provided that should the grantee cease to use said premises for railway purposes, and remove its rails therefrom, the same shall revert to the grantor.

The Railway Company shall have the right to enter upon the lands of grantor adjoining said premises for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating said track or tracks.


