Kittitas County Community Development Services (CDS) received your Ranch Road Final Plat submittal on March 13, 2019 and your response to the request for additional information on April 2, 2019. Final plats must be processed and approved by BOCC within 30 days of the submittal date. Kittitas County staff has completed the review of your revised final plat submittal from April 2, 2019. As provided below, staff has the following comments, requirements, and/or revisions for your application that need to be addressed prior to final approval and signature of the final plat mylars:

In order to obtain final approval, the following must be addressed:

"3. The ownership of public right of way should be clarified as being county or state. *EX: "Burke Rd - County R/W - Paved""*

Please see the attached Public Works memo dated April 3, 2019 for the complete comment/required changes.

Environmental Health (email attached):

Environmental Health's comment letter includes no additional requirements.

Please provide an updated mylar (sheets that require changes or the licensed surveyor can come to Kittitas County CDS office and hand edit the mylar to reflect the required information) showing all required changes as required by Public Works. Once the requested information has been resubmitted or corrected in person, CDS will route the information to the various departments to review for consistency. As stated above, review, signature, and approval of this plat must occur within 30 days of March 13, 2019. Therefore, this plat must be placed on the April 8th Study Session Agenda (the last board meeting within the 30 day window) for Board decision and signature. With that said, all revised information needs to be submitted to Kittitas County CDS by end of business day <u>April 4th</u>, 2019 for staff review and signature on the final mylars (this assumes all issues have been addressed adequately

and required information has been provided). If the required information is not provided by the date listed above, then staff will recommend denial of this plat to the BOCC on April 8, 2019 unless you provide in writing an agreement to an extension for BOCC signature on April 16, 2019, which is the next BOCC meeting pursuant to RCW 58.17.140(2) and provide all required information as listed above no later than April 9, 2019.
