Good afternoon Alex.

I have had a chance to review the draft conservation plat drawing layout pdf that you sent yesterday afternoon with Dusty.

The draft proposed 4-lot drawing does appear to meet the requirements necessary to continue processing this application as a conservation short plat. By continuing with this proposal as a short plat (4 lots total) you are not subject to SEPA review, therefore a SEPA checklist is not required to be submitted. Additionally, we will not require a new conservation short plat application, we already have your original one on file. We will need you to submit a revised project narrative which is question #9 of the application to reflect your new parcel configurations and address the building envelope size which you current show on your drawing plans. I have attached your original application for your reference.

Once Kittitas County CDS has received your revised preliminary short plat drawings and project narrative, Dusty Pilkington, the planner of record will continue processing your proposal. The estimated timeline for completion of the preliminary plat process is two (2) to four (4) months (we have been processing closer to 2 to 3 months with our current work load and pending no significant issues arise during comment period) and will include the following:

- 1. Staff review of additional/revised information submitted
- 2. Next, a new Notice of Application will be put together and sent out for a 15 day comment period to adjacent landowners within 500 feet of the project boundary, published in the county paper of record, notice to other interested persons.
- 3. At the close of the public comment period, all comments received will be reviewed by staff and will also be provided to the applicant.
- 4. A request of additional information based on comments received will be issued if necessary
- 5. Staff Report, Findings and Conclusions Document and a Notice of Decision will be made and issued.
