Dusty,

As mentioned on the phone, the work we were hoping to cover under the attached shoreline exemption application has now become critical. The Yakima River level has dropped dramatically causing the river to be diverted away from our water intake for the City's drinking water system. This means we need to get in there and do the work on Tuesday to get the debris moved as planned within the attached , so we can get the water to the intake structure.

We request an emergency approval, or an after-the-fact approval so we can maintain our City water system.
