

RE: Submittal Shoreline Exemption for Grant PUD's Airstrip Fence Installation

To Whom is may concern,

Public Utility District No. 2 of Grant County, Washington (Grant PUD) is proposing to install a new fence at the Airstrip property site in Kittitas County (see attached site map). A fence was installed in 2007 but was destroyed in a wildlife.

This proposal consists of installing a fence to delineate Grant PUD's property boundary from the adjacent new Vantage Bay development in Kittitas County. The installation of the fence along the property boundary will assist to curtail potential encroachments and minimize ground disturbances to prevent damage to the vegetation and shoreline.

The fence will be constructed of 5.5 foot posts with 2 strands of ¼ inch barbless wire and will not exceed 4 feet in total height. The top and bottom wires will be at the heights of 18 inches and 40 inches. The t-posts will be approximately 10 feet apart, for a total distance of 4,200 feet. The fence will not be closer than 120 feet from the slough-wetland area. There will be two public pedestrian access points on the fence line.

A Shoreline Development Permit was issued in 2007 when the original fence was installed. Permits were issued by Kittitas County with the numbers SSDP-06-04 and 2007-CS-10315 1.

Grant PUD is submitting the following forms and documents:

- Shoreline Exemption Permitting application form.
- SEPA letter of exemption.
- Site map and fence design.
- Check for the amount of \$1,100.00 for permit application fee.
