


- 3. The basis of bearings shown hereon is the Washington Coordinate System.
- 4. This survey was performed using a Lietz TMIOE IO" theodolite and a Topcon DMC2 EDM. The controlling manuments and property corners shown hereon were located, staked and checked from a closed field traverse in excess of 1:15,000 linear closure after azimuth adjustment and balanced by compass rule adjustment.
- 5. All monuments shown as found were visited in November of 1987.

SET 5/8" REBAR WITH SURVEY CAP






