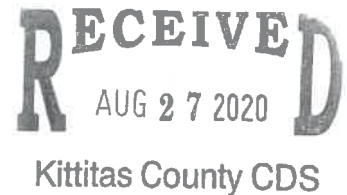

As a resident of this community, I am writing with strong opposition to the proposed SEPA request, and the accompanying project.

The location of these sewage ponds would adversely affect the health and well being, to not only my family, but the residents of the neighboring community. I have been a property owner here for over 14 years. To have the water and air quality compromised is not acceptable, not to mention the devaluation of our properties.

It is disturbing and very disappointing that this process appears to have been pushed through the permitting channels, with only a bureaucratic notification process, with little or no discussion with the property and homeowners. I am sure you are aware that the sewage storage ponds would lie immediately adjacent to The Parke Creek Group Home (Echo Glen) for boys, as well as The Operating Engineers Training Center.

I am requesting that you deny this application until a more suitable location can be attained, with less impact on farm and family communities.
