In reference to KCC 13.04.200(5) a sewage lagoon utilized to dump the contents removed from septic tanks or any other sewage collection receptacles would be subject to the Health Officers approval before any waste could be dumped and stored at the location. Areas of concern for the Kittitas County Health Department would include the protection of known areas of surface and ground water. Vector control would also need to be established along with the collection sites proximity to existing residences, and a mitigation plan to include how the site would prevent environmental health issues that could be detrimental to the surrounding residences.
