Location: Tax parcel 508933. located on Stone Road approximately .13 miles south of the intersection of Canyon Road and Stone Road, in Section 24, Township 17N, Range 18E, W.M. in Kittitas County.

Proposal: Kittitas County Public Works is proposing the Spring Creek Restoration Project which will include the removal of two existing culverts on Spring Creek to improve hydrologic function and connectivity, treatment of noxious weeds, planting of native woody species, and native grass seeding. The project is proposed on a site that is zoned Agriculture 20 within a Rural Working Land Use designation.

Written Comments from the public may be submitted to the Kittitas County Community Development Services no later than **Wednesday, May 5, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.**, after which a SEPA threshold determination will be issued pursuant to 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act). A Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance is expected to be issued. A copy of this subsequent threshold determination will be available to the public upon request. This proposal may include, incorporate, or require mitigation measures under applicable codes regardless of whether a Determination of Significance (DS) is issued and subsequent Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared.
