NOTICE IS HEREBY given that pursuant to WAC 197-11-355 and RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c), Kittitas County Community Development Services did, on April 28, 2022, issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on the proposed SEPA application submitted by Doug & Dia Cooper. The applicant, Doug & Dia Cooper, are proposing to construct a new 1536 square-foot shop which requires a Class IV Forest Practices Act permit per the Department of Natural Resources. The subject parcel is in Forest & Range zoning with a Rural Working land use designation. The project area is located on Tax parcel# 112436 located off Upland Road, approximately 0.28 miles west of the intersection of Upland Road and North Fork Teanaway Road, in a portion of the southeast ¼ of the southwest ¼ of Section 31, Township 21, Range 16, bearing Assessor's Map # 21-16-31030-0014 in Kittitas County.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C and WAC 197-11-355.
