Dear Ms. Bacon,

The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) is familiar with this area and habitat in and around nearby Mercer Creek. WDFW supports this project as it will remove fill from the floodplain and wetlands adjacent to Mercer Creek.

The northwest portion of the project is very close to Mercer Creek and a point of diversion. We recommend extreme care be used when installing and removing the silt fencing to avoid disturbance of riparian vegetation and to ensure that the bank integrity is not disturbed. Upon project completion, we welcome the opportunity to collaborate with the landowner on native riparian plantings and helping address the currently unscreened irrigation diversion on this property. Our hope is that this work will not only benefit fish and wildlife habitat, but also help reduce flood risks to the property.
