We, the undersigned, twelve Freeholders of the Township hereinafter named, all of whom reside in the vicinity of the following described proposed Road, pray that a Public Road be established in said County, having its points of beginning and termination, course and intermediate points as follows:

Commencing at a point on the Public County Road known as the Lake Outlet Road at the south end of Nelsons Lane - in Road District No. 5 East the District and running in an easterly direction to John Beckins Junction on the Skutumpah River - crossing the same about three hundred feet below the Northern Bay's Rail Road Bridge at which crossing there continuing in an easterly direction to the El Estero River and crossing the same at a point about one hundred and fifty feet above the El Estero See Campbells head gate - then continuing in an easterly direction to a point on the Edinburgh and El Estero Lake Road marked by a pin the in Section 28 Township 20 N. R. 15 E. 20 in. in Road District 15

and ending at or as near said Mark as practicable

in Section 28, Township 20 N., Range 15 E. - 20 in. the whole distance being about 4 1/2 miles and your

petitioners pray that a Survey of such proposed Road may be ordered. And your petitioners will ever pray, etc.
