1 2 SUPERIOR COURT OF WASHINGTON FOR KITTITAS COUNTY 3 4 IN RE THE MATTER OF 5 **ESTABLISHING WEAPON FREE ZONES** 6 7 WHEREAS: The safety of court personnel, county employees involved in judicial process, and citizens accessing court functions of Kittitas County are important welfare. public health and safety concerns; and 9 10 WHEREAS: The legislature has preempted the entire field of firearm regulation within the boundaries of the State in RCW 9.41.290; and 11 12 WHEREAS: RCW 9.41.300 directs the local Judicial Authority to designate and clearly mark those areas where weapons are restricted in accordance with RCW 9.41.300; and 13 WHEREAS: The Judges of the District Courts of Kittitas County concur by their signatures herein with the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court issuing this order; and 15 WHEREAS: The Board of Kittitas County Commissioners has in Ordinance 2009-02 16 directed the Kittitas County Maintenance Department to mark the areas of the courthouse as this Court Directs; and 17 18 WHEREAS: Ordinance 2009-02 also directs the Kittitas County Information Services Department to post a copy of any standing order of this Court on the Kittitas County 19 webpage; Now, Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the following areas are designated as weapon restricted and shall 21 be marked and posted as such: 22 In the Upper District Court facility: the lobby from the metal detector to the Courtroom, the Courtroom, the Clerk's Office, storage rooms, Judge's Chamber and 23 Jury room. 24 In the Kittitas County Courthouse: the second floor because it is impossible to 25 protect areas connected to court use without restricting ingress or egress to the second floor. 26 27 In the Kittitas County Courthouse on the first floor: the west wing, commencing

at the bottom of the stairs leading to the Lower District Court because it is impossible to

protect areas connected to court use without restricting ingress and egress to the west wing; and when in use as an additional courtroom, the Commissioner's Auditorium, and

its adjoining entry way area.
