Dear Commissioner Berndt,

As an individual, I wish to be considered for a membership on a new public lands advisory committee if it becomes a reality. The hot button issue right now seems to be management of public lands in the Colockum, Quilomene, and Whiskey Dick wildlife areas. I am a near neighbor to these WLA's and have been all my life, as was my father, my grandfather and my great grandfather. Over 20,000 acres in this area was owned by my family since the 1870's and was sold in the 1960's. We ranged cattle over that land and another 20,000 plus acres of leased land to the Columbia River. I've spent my entire life enjoying what nature has to offer on these lands and beyond in Kittitas County. As a child and somewhat younger adult, I remember driving cattle out in the spring, picnicking often at the Pines (sometimes overnight) and visiting Clarence Scammon's at the mouth of Skookumchuck Creek. So, these lands are near and dear to me and my family. I farm hay and grain in the Fairview area and know the landowners in the vicinity with issues over managing marauding elk herds and have dealt with some of the same problems on my own lands. Mcmean's, Martin's, Charlton's, Stingley's, Webber's, Kayser's, and others in that area are my friends/neighbors that have to deal with elk issues. My part-time employment for the past 27 years with the DFW in winter elk management, elk surveys and elk related issues has gained me valuable experience and knowledge which I believe could be helpful in resolving some conflicts. 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Keith R. McGowan - Selected Experience, 12/18/2013

SR 2 Stevens Pass Greenway Scenic Byway Management Plan, Chelan, King, and Snohomish Counties. Mr. McGowan prepared the recreation, tourism, and land use elements of the corridor management plan for the Stevens Pass Greenway Scenic Byway for the Stevens Pass Greenway Steering Committee and WSDOT Heritage Corridors Program. Initial assessments included research of existing and planned land use development, recreation resource management, and effectiveness of land use plans and controls in preserving and enhancing the intrinsic qualities of the corridor. Investigations also included extensive coordination with residents, opinion leaders, and board members; as well as interviews with public and private recreation providers, major landowners, tourism-based businesses, and chambers of commerce to gain an understanding of community visions and values within the corridor. This provided a foundation for developing strategies for land use and resource management to enhance recreation opportunities within the corridor, with an emphasis on improving the contribution of tourism to local economies. The refined strategies were used to develop specific recommendations for facilities, interpretive and informational signing, and access improvements.

Blue River Reservoir and Cougar Reservoir Comprehensive Recreation Plan, Oregon. Mr. McGowan served as Planning Team Leader for this U.S. Forest Service and Army Corps of Engineers interagency recreation plan for a 12,000-acre site encompassing two reservoirs in the central Oregon Cascades. The plan identified recreation participation, resource deficiencies, approaches to restore and protect damaged resources, opportunities to develop and sustain new recreation resources, and recommendations for management of recreation resources and use. An on-site survey was administered to gain data regarding user origins, activity participation, constraints to use, and perceptions of recreation resource needs. Key management issues included soil erosion, water quality, resource protection, visual quality, public safety, and tradeoffs among resource uses. In addition to managing the planning process, Mr. McGowan conducted the resource capability assessment, analyzed recreation carrying capacities for the reservoirs and surrounding area, and collaborated in the market area analysis.

Tiger Mountain State Forest Planning and Management Studies, King County. Mr. McGowan was lead investigator for this interagency research project co-sponsored by the Washington Department of Natural Resources and U.S. Forest Service. Coordinating with other resource professionals, Mr. McGowan developed a computer simulation model of forest growth, timber management, and benefit yield for Tiger Mountain State Forest near Issaquah in the central Cascades. He then demonstrated the model at a seminar for resource agencies and private land managers as a tool for analyzing the effects of alternative management prescriptions on yields of forest resources including timber, wildlife habitat, water, recreation, and visual quality.

Analysis of Outdoor Recreation Participation, Willamette National Forest, Oregon. Mr. McGowan developed an empirical model of participation in forest-based recreation for the U.S. Forest Service as part of the Forest Land and Resource Management Plan for the Willamette National Forest. The primary focus of the study was to examine demographic and socioeconomic variables that influence rates of participation in developed, dispersed, and wilderness recreation. Study results were used to interpret trends in outdoor recreation and develop estimates of recreation participation as part of resource planning and allocation.

City of Florence Tourism Study, Oregon. Mr. McGowan prepared an analysis of existing tourism and its potential contribution to economic development for the City of Florence. The study inventoried recreation and tourism resources in the surrounding area, documented the contribution of tourism to employment and the local economy, and identified opportunities to increase tourism and capture its benefits. A key element of the study was description of visitor characteristics based on a sample survey from local guest registers. Among the variables analyzed were household characteristics, city and state of residence, trip characteristics, motivations for visiting the area, level of satisfaction, and expenditures. An extensive set of recommendations was developed in cooperation with the City, Chamber of Commerce, Old Town Association, and Port of Siuslaw that identified their distinct and shared roles in facilitating tourism. In addition, a tourism promotion strategy was proposed that focused resources and amenities in support of a unified marketing theme.

Land Use, Socioeconomic, and Resource Management Studies, Southeast Alaska. As a research scientist with the U.S. Forest Service, Mr. McGowan correlated field investigations with extensive statistical analysis of an interagency survey of Alaskan residents to evaluate the effects of timber management, mineral extraction, and road system development on dispersed recreation, subsistence, and other community-related forest uses. He also designed several investigations to evaluate the distribution and adequacy of recreation opportunities for residents and tourists in southeast Alaska, with a focus on land use, resource recreation, public access, and visual quality. He participated frequently with resource managers and planning teams applying the research results to develop mitigation and enhancement strategies for the management of public forests.

Pierce County Foothills Trail SEPA EIS, Pierce County. Mr. McGowan managed the Environmental Impact Statement for conversion of an abandoned 25-mile railroad corridor to a multi-use recreation trail. The historic corridor extends east from Orting along the Carbon River and South Prairie Creek to South Prairie, and then south to Wilkeson and Carbonado. Ownership within the corridor was divided among multiple local jurisdictions and private parties. Numerous stream and highway crossings had to be negotiated, and several large trestles required rehabilitation or replacement. Key issues included recreation, water quality, wetland and riparian areas, land use, plans and policies of affected jurisdictions, traffic, and public safety.

Mountain Loop Scenic Byway Improvements NEPA EIS, Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest, Washington. Mr. McGowan directed environmental studies for this interagency Environmental Impact Statement prepared for the Federal Highway Administration and U.S. Forest Service. The proposal was to widen, realign, and pave a 14-mile-long section of this Scenic Byway in the Cascades near Darrington. Mr. McGowan coordinated extensively with federal and local agencies during the design and conduct of studies of vegetation, wildlife, fisheries, and habitat within the 20,000-acre project vicinity. Stream special surveys were conducted to characterize habitat conditions and evaluate populations of bull trout and salmonids.

North Fork Falls Trails NEPA Environmental Assessment, Siuslaw National Forest, Oregon. Mr. McGowan managed the Environmental Assessment examining development of a non-motorized trail system and dispersed recreation area in the politically and environmentally sensitive watersheds of Kentucky Creek and Smith Creek near Mapleton. He conducted early site reconnaissance, and then worked with a team of other environmental scientists, foresters, and engineers to lay out the trail, stream crossings, and a blasted route along a rock face to access and showcase three major waterfalls. The trail corridor was subsequently designated a Scenic Area by the U.S. Forest Service, and has been featured in Sunset Magazine. The area also is frequently cited as a case study for how timber management can occur in proximity to designated scenic and recreation resources.

Enumclaw Community Plan SEPA EIS, King County. Mr. McGowan was project manager for this Environmental Impact Statement on the Enumclaw Community Plan and Area Zoning prepared for King County. The EIS analyzed effects of plan policies and new zoning designations within the 82,000-acre planning area on residential and commercial development, agriculture, and forestry. The relationship to plans and policies of affected jurisdictions, and demands on public services, community development, population and housing, aesthetics, and the transportation system were key issues.

Port of Seattle Piers 1 and 2 Redevelopment, Citizen's Advisory Committee, City of Seattle. Mr. McGowan chaired the Citizen's Advisory Committee assembled by the City of Seattle and served as an ex-officio member of the multijurisdictional Project Management Team for this mixed-use redevelopment project. The project site consisted of several Industrial-zoned waterfront and upland parcels owned by a number of public and private entities. It borders a public waterfront park on the north and industrial waterfront along the Duwamish Waterway to the south. Three thematic development scenarios were examined emphasizing industrial, mixed-use/residential, and open space/community business uses. Mr. McGowan participated in alternatives development and refinement, and helped critique analyses prepared by the City's consultant team. Each scenario was evaluated for economic viability, environmental impacts, compatibility with existing and planned land use, traffic and transportation, and effect on community character. Findings and recommendations were advanced to the City Council and Port of Seattle for use in considering a potential amendment to the City Comprehensive Plan and subsequent contract rezone.


