responsible bid from Prater Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$7,560,00 was

deemed the lowest responsive bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners declares it be in the best interest of the public, and does hereby authorize the award of the beacon replacement project to Prater Electric, Inc.in the amount of \$7,560.00.
