**RESOLUTION NO. 2015- 130**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN KITTITAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE WASHINGTON TRAFFIC  
SAFETY COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides the capability for public agencies to cooperate by providing services and facilities for mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Traffic Safety Commission has and will provide funding to law enforcement agencies to conduct multijurisdictional, high visibility enforcement (HVE) traffic safety emphasis patrols targeting impaired and distracted driving; and

WHEREAS, the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office desires to engage in such patrols as part of this national effort on some of the dates listed in the Agreement that is the subject of this resolution depending on personnel availability; and

WHEREAS, this agreement if made and entered into by and between the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office and the Washington Traffic Safety Commission will provide overtime funding to conduct such traffic safety emphasis patrols, in support of Target Zero priorities and;

WHEREAS, that funding facilitates the goals and duties of the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office in providing these emphasis patrols while reducing the fiscal impact on the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act chapter 39.34 RCW, between Kittitas County Sheriff's Office and the Washington Traffic Safety Commission for high visibility emphasis patrol, is adopted and shall be forthwith filed with the Kittitas County Auditor pursuant to RCW 39.34.040.
