Kittitas County solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in Civil Engineering Design. Consultants will be considered for the following project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT consists of preparing preliminary engineering design for some improvements to No 6 Road. The proposed improvements include shoulders, increasing intersection radii, and overlaying the existing roadway and construction of retaining walls to provide for roadway widening. The major features of the project are as follows:

- Approximately 1.5 miles of road and shoulder widening.
- Associated roadside safety features.
- Improving intersection radii to meet design standards.
- Environmental planning and preparation of permit applications.
- Design of retaining walls, and culvert extensions/replacements.

SUBMITTAL

Submittals shall include the following information: firm name, phone and fax numbers; name of principal-in-charge and project manager; proof of current Washington State Department of Transportation audited Indirect Cost Rates for all proposed consulting and sub-consulting firms; and number of employees in each firm proposed to work on this project.

Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria:

1) Key personnel; 2) Firm experience with road design; 3) Firm experience with environmental planning and permitting process; 4) Ability to meet schedule; 5) Approach to project; 6) Familiarity with relevant codes and standards; 7) Past performance/references.

KITTITAS COUNTY encourages disadvantaged business enterprise consulting firms to respond.
