AGENDA DATE: January 17th, 2017

ACTION REQUESTED: Set a Public Hearing to consider amending Kittitas County Code for Public Works and Community Development Services fees language.

BACKGROUND: Public Works and Community Development Services are currently reviewing and amending permit fees department wide. It has been found that language throughout the code does not accurately depict current fees or the update and adoption processes for fee schedules.

Public Works and Community Development Services desire to adopt similar language used by the Kittitas County Health Department such that County Code will acknowledge and address fees in Title Four; and that fee schedules will be adopted by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.

Public Works and Community Development Services suggest amending Kittitas County Code by ordinance to remove applicable fee language residing throughout the code and consolidating the fee process and appropriate language in Title 4.
