**A Resolution to Call a Special Election to Determine if the
City of Kittitas Should Be Annexed to Kittitas County Fire District #2**

- WHEREAS,** The City of Kittitas, on July 24, 2017, passed Ordinance No. 17-013 stating an intent to join Kittitas County Fire District #2 and declaring that the public interest will be served thereby; and
- WHEREAS,** Kittitas County Fire District #2, on July 25, 2017, passed Resolution No. 17-10, concurring in the above mentioned annexation; and
- WHEREAS,** Kittitas County Fire District #2 transmitted notification of the above mentioned legislative activity to the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners, and
- WHEREAS,** RCW 52.04.071 states that, upon receipt of the above described decisions and corresponding legislative acts, "The county legislative authority . . . shall by resolution call a special election to be held in the city or town and in the fire protection district at the next date provided in RCW [29A.04.321]."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

1. A special election shall be called in the City of Kittitas and in the current boundaries of Kittitas County Fire District #2 to determine if The City of Kittitas should be annexed to Kittitas County Fire District #2;
2. The above called election shall occur on the next date provided by RCW 29A.04.321, and notice thereof shall be given as provided by RCW 29A.52.351; and
3. The ballot title shall be in substantially the following form:
