## RESOLUTION SPECIFYING FUNDING FOR THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN KITTITAS COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT AND MERIT RESOURCES

WHEREAS, the Kittitas County Superior Court has established a drug court; and

WHEREAS, the Kittitas County Superior Court entered into an MOU with ADDS prior

to the adoption of Resolution 2009-002; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Kittitas County Commissioners funded the Superior Court

MOU for the 2009 calendar year, through Resolution 2009-23; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Kittitas County Commissioners finds that the Kittitas County

Superior Court Drug Court provides a valuable service to the community; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2005-108 established fund 115 Trial Court Improvement Fund;

and

WHEREAS, the local judicial authority has stated its collective desire that a portion of

the fund 115 be used to provide funding for the before mentioned MOU; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2009-002 amended fund 131 Drug Enforcement Reserve Fund to allow the funds therein to be used for the expenses of the local drug court; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that:

The Memorandum of Understanding between Kittitas County Superior Court and Merit Resources f/k/a Alcohol Drug Dependency Services (ADDS) is hereby ratified and shall be funded for the 2016 calendar year as follows:

- A. \$12,000 from the General Fund. These funds were previously authorized for the Drug Court specially to pay for urinalysis.
- B. \$10,000 from fund 131 Drug Enforcement Reserve Fund.
- C. \$44,996 from fund 115 Trial Court Improvement Fund.

This ratification is limited to the MOU being conditioned upon future funding

appropriations by the Board.
