RESOLUTION AWARDING FUNDING FOR GRANTS PURSUANT TO LAW AND JUSTICE COUNCIL RECOMMENDATIONS ON SPENDING OF 1/10TH OF 1% SALES TAX RESERVES

- **WHEREAS**: The Kittitas County Law and Justice Council met at their regularly scheduled meeting on August 21, 2013, and voted unanimously for the below described funding recommendations; and
- **WHEREAS:** These expenditures shall be made from the 1/10th of 1% sales tax reserve account established by the Board of County Commissioners for spending on special projects to foster cooperation, sharing of resources and enhancement of criminal justice projects within Kittitas County; and
- **WHEREAS**: Funding is to be made available January 1, 2014 except where noted as available upon approval of resolution; and
- WHEREAS: The amount authorized for 2014 grants is \$20,000.00. Current balance in the grant funds is approximately \$80,000.00 with \$30,000.00 in reserve for development of a firing range, and the balance for special Law and Justice Projects approved by the Board of County Commissioners.
- **WHEREAS**: The Kittitas County Law and Justice Council and the Board of County Commissioners have deemed these expenditures in the best interest of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the following funding recommendations as made by the Kittitas County Law and Justice Council and these expenditures shall be made from the $1/10^{\text{th}}$ of 1% sales tax reserve account.
