



AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO

CONTRACT NO. C1600148

BETWEEN THE

STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY

AND

KITTITAS COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT

PURPOSE: To amend the Agreement between the state of Washington, Department of Ecology, hereinafter referred to as "ECOLOGY," and Kittitas County Public Health Department, hereinafter referred to as "KCPHD" or "CONTRACTOR."

WHEREAS, it is mutually agreed that KCPHD's request for flexibility within the budget, with Ecology's prior written approval, is beneficial and should therefore be permitted.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED the Agreement is amended as follows:

1) BUDGET

The budget has been amended TO ALLOW FOR A SHIFT OF UP TO \$8,000 BETWEEN Payroll items and non-payroll items, subject to Ecology's written approval, see Project Budget Table:
