RESOLUTION NO11-042

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE 2012 REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roslyn held a public hearing on the 2012 Preliminary Budget to consider revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, after considering the projected 2012 revenues and expenditures and listening to all testimony the City held a public hearing on the 2012 property tax levy; and

WHEREAS, after considering all testimony and deliberations on the projected 2012 revenues and expenditures and tax levy, the City Council of the City of Roslyn has determined that the City requires the 1% Tax Levy increase, in order to sustain and improve the level of service provided to the citizens of the City of Roslyn; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn's population is under 10,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> A regular property tax is hereby levied for 2012 in the amount of \$185,713.54 which represents a 1% increase of \$1,838.75, in the regular property tax levy from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any other increase in value of state assessed property.
