  - Report to City Council
  - Meeting of ALTC Advisory Reps with Adult Community Center Advisory Board – spring 2010
  - The results of this meeting were that people began to be more interested in the possibilities
- Meeting with Mayor Summer 2011
  - Formation of ideas about group meeting to explore a vision for the community in 3 to 5 years
  - Set a tentative date for October
- Letter from Bruce concerning meeting to be held October 18
- Meeting held on October 18 – Bruce Tabb was the facilitator  
Purpose of meeting: to do some visioning about the issues relating to a “one stop” community center

Fear of change  
Educating the public (including today's presentation)  
Gaining stakeholder consensus
