ACTION REQUESTED: Request to Approve a Special Event Application to hold the

"Your Canyon for a Day" event on May 20, 2012

BACKGROUND: The Commissioners office received a Special Event

application from Crime Stoppers of Yakima County, to hold the annual "Your Canyon for a Day" event on May 20, 2012.

INTERACTION: The applicant is also requesting a waiver to the following:

Kittitas County Code Chapter 5.20.100 – Penal Bond – Bond of Indemnity - The applicant has provided proof of insurance and believes that it should be adequate coverage, since their ride has proven to have no effect on the roads in

the past.

The applicant will also need a waiver to **Kittitas County Code Chapter 5.20.160 – Closing Hours** since their event is scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. and according to the County Code, events shall not be open to the public before

the hour of 10:00 a.m.

The permit fee has been paid and staff has routed the application and received a recommendation of approval from the following departments: Sheriff, Public Health, Public Works, Solid Waste, Prosecutor and Fire Marshal. There has

been no response from the Auditor.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve holding the annual "Your Canyon for a Day" event

on May 20, 2012 and to grant a waiver of Kittitas County Code Chapters 5.20.160 and 5.20.100. Noting they must comply with County department recommendations and

criteria.
