ACTION REQUESTED:

Request the ratification of the signature of the public health administrator, executing the Consolidated Contract Amendment 6 between Kittitas County Public Health Department and Washington State Department of Health. (Effective dates: January 2012-December 2014)

BACKGROUND:

The Consolidated Contract is the vehicle used by the Washington State Department of Health to channel state authorized funding for programs and services to the Kittitas County Public Health Department. This agreement represents the 6th amendment to the Consolidated Contract and provides funding to support the services provided by the Kittitas County Public Health Department. The Consolidated Contract amendment 6 adds statements of work for the Maternal Child Health Block Grant, Office of Immunization and Child Profile, OICP-PPHF Reimbursement Project, and Performance Management Center for Excellence-Quality Improvement Project. The Consolidated Contract also amends the statement of work for the Office of Drinking Water Group A Program and increases the county allocation to \$47,461.

INTERACTION:

Kittitas County Board of Health: The Consolidated Contract is on the agenda for the February 21, 2013 meeting.

Kittitas County Auditor's Office: Contract was reviewed and approved by the Kittitas County Auditor's office on January 30, 2013.

Kittitas County Prosecutor's Office: Contract was reviewed and approved by the Kittitas County Prosecutor's Office on January 18, 2013.
