ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Resolution Authorizing an Interagency Agreement between Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board and City of Ellensburg for Noxious Weed Control.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Ellensburg requested an interlocal agreement with the Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board for weed control work on City owed property. This Interlocal Agreement, not to exceed \$10,000, has the potential to be renewed annually and does not obligate the Weed Board to any specifice work. It is hoped this agreement will allow the Weed Board to address several noxious weed concerns within the city and allow the Weed Board to be reimbursed for work on those projects. This interlocal agreement is similar to other Weed Board agreements with State Parks and the Dept. of Natural Resources that have proven to be quite beneficial toward weed control in Kittitas County as a whole.

INTERACTION:

The City of Ellensburg submitted an interlocal agreement to the Weed Board for signature after having discussed the proposal with the City Public Works Director, John Akers. The Prosecutor's Office has reviewed and approved the contract as to form, the Auditor's Office has reviewed and approved the contract, and the Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board has reviewed and approved the contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners approve the resolution to authorize execution of an Interlocal Agreement between Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board and the City of Ellensburg for noxious weed control on City owned properties.
