AGENDA DATE: March 19, 2013

ACTION REQUESTED: Set a public hearing on April 2, 2013 to consider adding a no parking zone on Kachess Lake Road and amending Kittitas County Code "No Parking Areas," Section 10.07.010 "Areas designated."

BACKGROUND: The Fire District No. 8 requested that a no parking zone be designated on Kachess Lake Road as allowed under RCW 46.61.570(1)(b)(v):

- (1) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall: (b) Stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers: (v) Within twenty feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy-five feet of said entrance when properly signposted;

The proposed no parking area on Kachess Lake Road is from milepost 2.895 to milepost 2.940. The length of this proposed no parking zone exceeds the distance requirements in the above RCW by five to ten feet. Also, this section of Kachess Lake Road is currently in a no parking zone during the winter season and this proposed change would be effective throughout the year.
