## **GRANT COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT**

#### **AMENDMENT #2**

**PURPOSE OF CHANGE**: To amend the INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT for the Community Transformation Grant between GRANT COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT hereinafter referred to as "GRANT", and Kittitas County Public Health, hereinafter referred to as "PARTICIPANT", under the provisions of the Agreement Alterations and Amendments clause therein, and to make necessary changes and additions within the scope of that contract to include extension of the contract through June 30, 2013 September 29, 2013 and to add additional funding for participation in approved CTG work.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THEREFORE: That the contract is hereby amended as follows to include:

Reimbursement up to \$25,000 shall be paid for CTG work in either or both (funding source #1, #2 and #3):

- Capacity Building: Coordinating with GCHD to ensure the implementation of the accepted proposal to build capacity within your community to achieve a policy, environmental, or system change, using an integrated approach toward Tobacco Free Living, Healthy Eating and Active Living. Action Plan must be approved by April 1, 2013 August 30, 2013.
- 2. Implementation: Coordinating with GCHD to ensure the implementation of the accepted proposal to achieve a policy, environmental or system change toward Tobacco Free Living, Active Living or Healthy Eating.

#### Reimbursement up to \$1,633 (funding source #1, #2 and #3) shall be paid for:

 Registration, travel and per diem costs at Joint Conference on Health held in October, 2012, October, 2013 and participation in regional coalition.

Reimbursement up to \$4,000 (funding source #3) shall be paid for CTG work in:

- 1. PARTICIPANT will work towards workplace breastfeeding policies and environmental changes to make workplaces more breastfeeding friendly.
- 2. PARTICIPANT will explore options with the county hospital on becoming a Baby Friendly Hospital.
- PARTICIPANT will assist Kittitas County with the policy, systems and environments relevant to workplace wellness.
- 4. PARTICIPANT will work with local food banks on access to healthy foods.
- 5. PARTICIPANT will explore increasing access to drinking water with the City of Ellensburg.
- 6. PARTICIPANT will assist child care centers to create and/or strengthen their healthy eating policies.

#### Reimbursement up to \$3,000 (funding source #3) shall be paid for CTG work in:

1. PARTICIPANT will participate in at least 80% of the Regional Smoke-Free College Campus workgroup meetings.

2. PARTICIPANT will provide outreach and technical assistance on smoke-free college campus policies to Kittitas County's one university.
